### **Institut Seni Indonesia (ISI)**

ISI is one of the finest and most respected schools for the arts in Indonesia. There are 250 lecturers for 2,500 students, with an average of 25 foreign students per year. The campus is located in Bantul, six kilometres south of central Yogyakarta.

### **Who can apply**

At present, the Indonesian Arts Study Option is only available as a second semester option for ACICIS students who have completed one semester at Gadjah Mada University (UGM). Anyone who is interested in learning more about the arts in Indonesia can apply. Past participants have included students, teachers, performers and private individuals.

### **About the Indonesian Arts Study Option**

There are three faculties at ISI: Performing Arts, Visual Arts and Media. Students can take courses at any of the faculties. Past students have studied gamelan, wayang kulit, dance, theatre, sculpture, ceramics, photography, batik and many other subjects.

Australian students who go to Indonesia with ACICIS normally get their courses credited towards their degree at their home university.

### **Application Closing Dates**

The application deadline is 1 October for the semester starting in January and 1 May for the semester starting in August.
