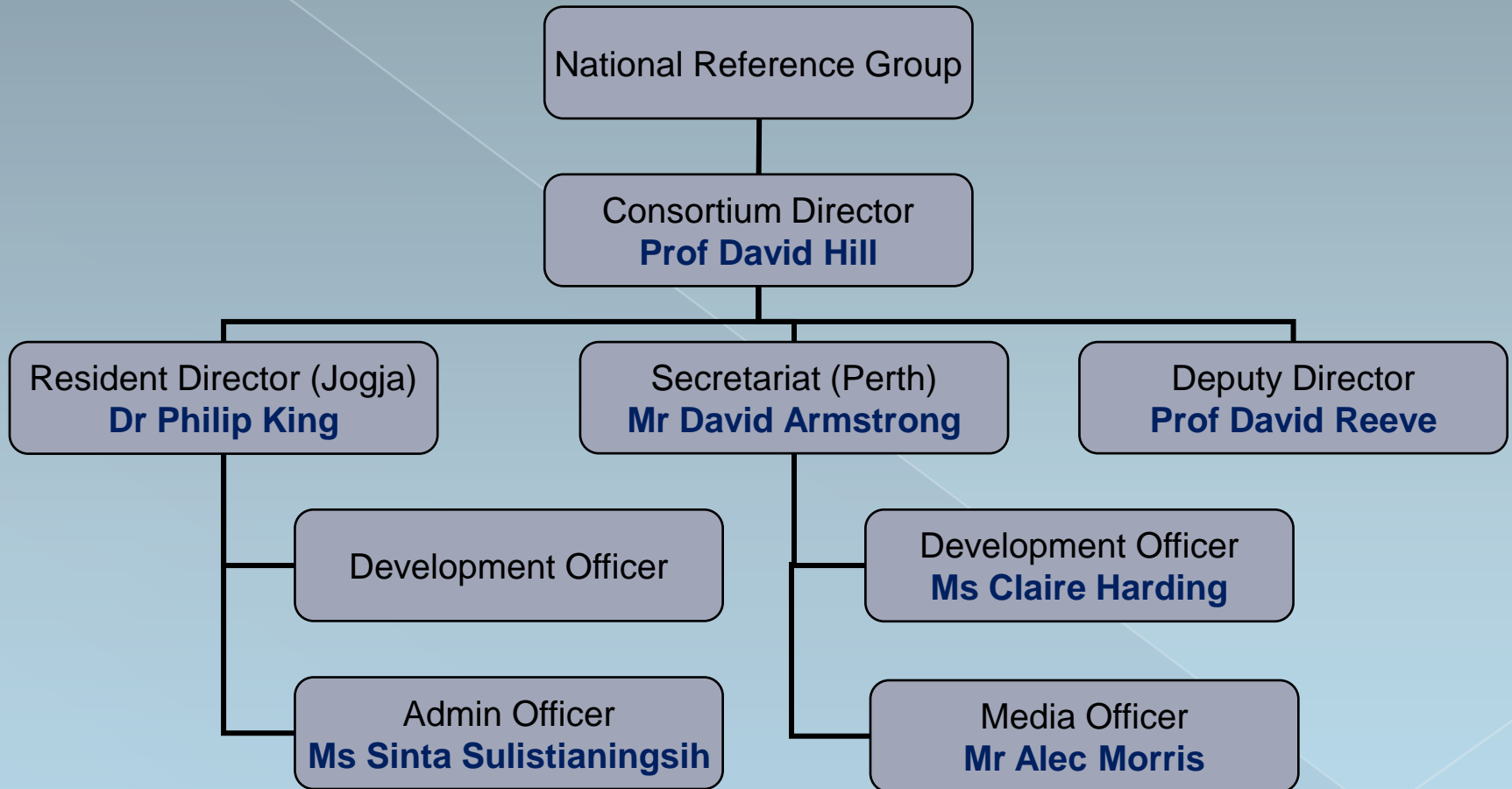

ACICIS Structure

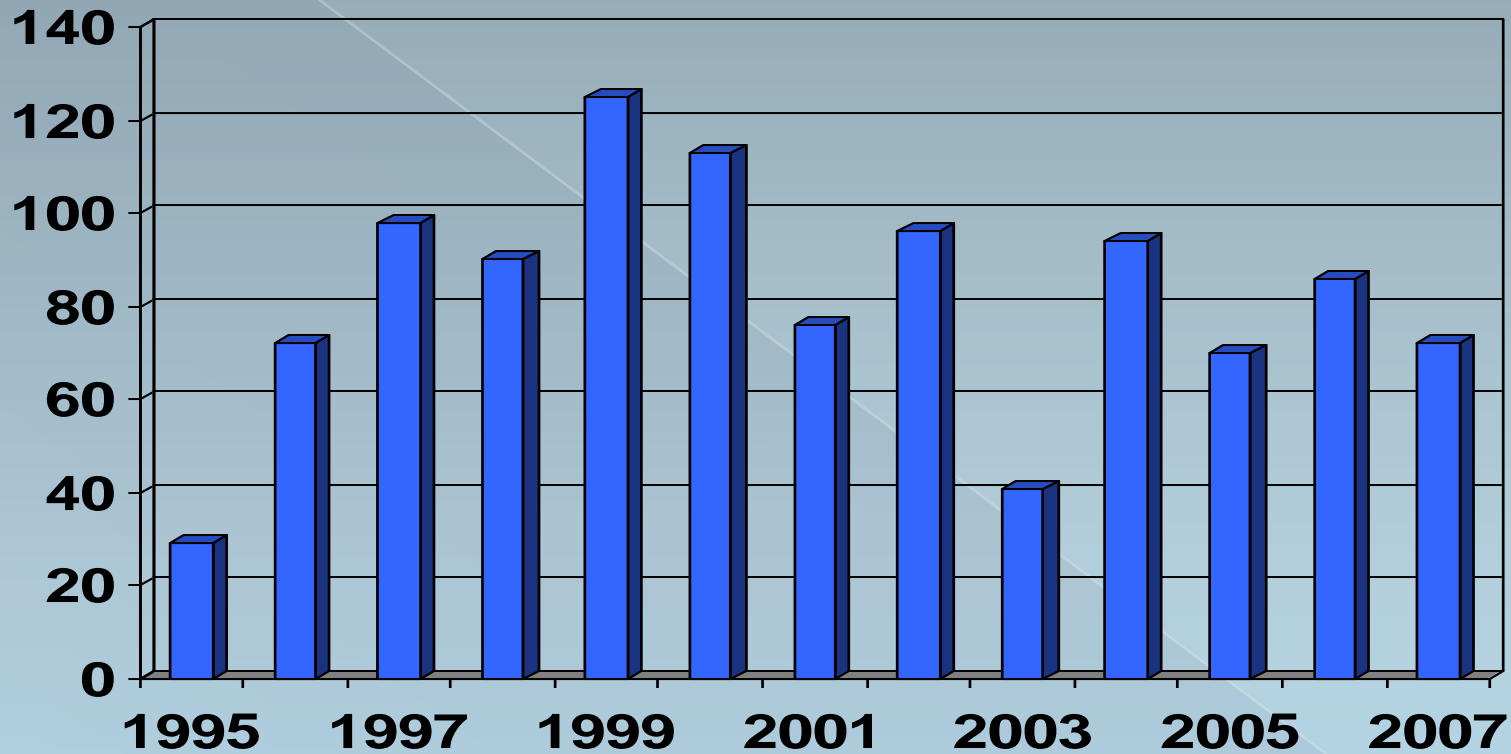
